L.A. County Polls Open for the Dec. 9, 2014 Senate District 35 Special Primary Election

Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan reminds eligible voters this morning that all [278 polling places](#) in Senate District 35 are now open for the Dec. 9, 2014 Senate District 35 Special Primary Election.

Polls opened at 7 a.m. today and close at 8 p.m. Voters can also drop their Vote by Mail ballot off at any polling place or at the Norwalk RR/CC Headquarters: 12400 Imperial Hwy., Norwalk, CA 90650.

Voters can find their polling place by going to www.lavote.net, looking at the back of their sample ballot booklet or calling (800) 815-2666, option 1.

For multilingual election materials and bilingual assistance in Chinese, Hindi, Japanese, Khmer, Korean, Spanish, Tagalog, Thai or Vietnamese, call (800) 481-8683. Additional pollworker assistance in Armenian, Bengali, Gujarati and Russian will be available at targeted polling places.
