<p><b>MAR. 6 (M)</b> E – 29</p>	<p><b>MAILING OF VOTE BY MAIL BALLOTS</b> No later than 29 days before the day of the election, the county elections official shall begin mailing the materials required by Section 3010. <b>(E. C. § 3001(b), 3010 and 3206)</b></p> <p><b>PROCESSING VOTE BY MAIL BALLOTS</b> The processing of vote by mail ballots may commence on the <b>29<sup>th</sup> day</b> before the election but the results of the tally shall not be released until after the vote centers close. (E. C. § 15101(b))</p>
<p><b>MAR. 14 (Tu)</b> E – 21</p>	<p><b>MAILING OF OFFICIAL SAMPLE BALLOT BOOKLETS (Historically commencing at E-40)</b> An Official Sample Ballot Booklet shall be mailed to each voter in the jurisdiction no later than 21 days before the election. <b>(E. C. § 13303)</b></p>
<p><b>MAR. 20 (M)</b> E – 15</p>	<p><b>CLOSE OF REGISTRATION</b> Last day to transfer or register to vote in the election. <b>(E. C. §§ 2102 (a) and 2107)</b></p>
<p><b>MAR. 21 (Tu)</b> E – 14</p>	<p><b>APR. 4 (Tu)</b> 8:00 P.M. ELECTION DAY</p> <p><b>NEW CITIZEN REGISTRATION/VOTING</b> A new citizen is eligible to register and vote at the office of, or at another location designated by, the county elections official at any time beginning on the <b>14<sup>th</sup> day</b> before an election and ending at the close of polls on the election day following the date on which that person became a citizen. <b>(E. C. § 3500)</b></p>

<p><b>MAR. 25 (Sa)</b> E – 10</p>	<p><b>TALLY CENTER LOCATION – PUBLICATION</b></p> <p>On or before this date a notice specifying the public place to be used as the central tally location for counting the ballots shall be published once in a newspaper of general circulation within the jurisdiction.</p> <p><b>(E. C. § 12109 and Govt. § 6061)</b></p>
<p><b>APRIL 4 (Tu)</b> <b>8:00 P.M.</b> ELECTION DAY</p>	<p><b>ELECTION DAY</b></p> <p>Polls open 7:00 a.m., close 8:00 p.m. <b>(E. C. §§ 1201 and 14212)</b></p> <p><b>VOTE BY MAIL BALLOTS RETURNED — 8:00 P.M.</b></p> <p>Last day for Vote By Mail ballots to be received or turned in personally by the voter at any polling place in the jurisdiction. An authorized representative may return the voted ballot under specified conditions. <b>(E. C. §§ 3017 and 3020)</b></p> <p>Any Vote By Mail ballot cast under this division shall be timely cast if it is received by the voter’s elections official via the United States Postal Service or a bona fide private mail delivery company no later than 7 days after election day in addition to the provisions set forth in E. C. 3020, Sections 1 and 2. <b>(E. C. § 3020(b) Section 1 and 2)</b></p>
<p><b>APRIL 6 (Th)</b> E + 2</p>	<p><b>OFFICIAL CANVASS</b></p> <p>The canvass of election returns shall commence no later than the first Thursday following the election. <b>(E. C. § 15301)</b></p>
<p><b>APRIL 14 (F)</b> E + 10</p>	<p><b>COMPLETION OF OFFICIAL CANVASS</b></p> <p>The county elections official shall prepare a certified statement of the results of the election and submit it to each jurisdiction within 30 days of the election. <b>(E. C. § 15372)</b></p> <p><b>NOTE:</b> On <b>Friday, April 14, 2023</b>, the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk is tentatively scheduled to certify the election results. On <b>Tuesday, April 18, 2023</b> the Board of Supervisors is tentatively scheduled to declare the election concluded. <b>(E. C. § 15400)</b></p>
