REVOCABLE TRANSFER ON DEATH DEED REJECTION INFORMATION

California Probate Code Sections 5600 – 5696 outlines the requirements for a Revocable Transfer on Death Deed. Your document was reviewed by the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk and found to not meet recording requirements. Please refer to the rejection reason(s) outlined in your letter and ensure they are all addressed *prior* to resubmitting your document and payment back to our office.

Please pay attention to the date your document was signed (executed) and acknowledged (notarized) to ensure you will not exceed the 60-day requirement. You may wish to have your document resigned and acknowledged to ensure the timeframe has not exceeded the 60 days to ensure it will be accepted by the Office of the Assessor.

Probate Code Section 5626.

(a) A revocable transfer on death deed is not effective unless the deed is recorded on or before 60 days after the date it was executed.
