First Post-Election Ballot Count Update for the City of Downey Special Municipal Election

LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced the first post-election ballot count update for the City of Downey Special Municipal Election.

The update includes **522** ballots processed since Election Night. The total election results count is now **3,747** which is **21.73%** of registered voters. Election results can be viewed on LAVOTE.GOV.

The [next post-election ballot count](#) will be on **Tuesday, February 7**.

The estimated number of outstanding ballots to be processed is **30** Vote by Mail ballots.

The RR/CC will continue to accept Vote by Mail ballots that are postmarked by Election Day and received through Tuesday, February 7 (E+7). These ballots are not included in the estimate.
