Last Day to Request a Vote by Mail Ballot for the June 4 Senate District 33 Special General Election and Municipal and Special Elections

LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan reminds eligible voters in Los Angeles County that **today at 11:59PM** is the deadline to request a Vote by Mail (VBM) ballot.

As of today, the RR/CC has issued **1,468,600** Vote by Mail ballots. Voters can request a Vote by Mail ballot by:

- Applying online at lavote.net
- Returning the VBM application on the back of the Sample Ballot
- Requesting a Vote by Mail ballot in person at the RR/CC headquarters: [12400 Imperial Highway, 3rd Floor \(Room 3002\), Norwalk CA 90650](#)

The newly redesigned Vote by Mail materials are easier to read, easier to understand, easier to fill out and easier to return – and, no postage is required to return the ballot. Track the status of your ballot online at lavote.net.

Please note all VBM ballots postmarked by Election Day will be counted if received within three (3) days by the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk ([E.C. § 3020](#)).
