Second Election Results Update for the Statewide Direct Primary Election

LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced the second ballot counting update for the Statewide Direct Primary Election.

The update includes **144,572** ballots processed since Election Night, consisting of Vote by Mail and Provisional ballots. The total election results count is now **1,180,472**, which is **22.97%** of eligible Los Angeles County voters.

The estimated number of outstanding ballots left to be counted:

Provisional ballots: 128,000
Vote by Mail ballots*: 170,000

• Misc. ballots**: 600

This estimate includes additional Vote by Mail Ballots postmarked on or before Election Day and received through today (E+3). These results are subject to change throughout the <u>Official Election</u> <u>Canvass</u> period as our canvass staff process VBM envelopes.
