**REQUEST TO AUTHORIZE THE REGISTRAR-RECORDER/COUNTY CLERK TO
PERFORM SNAP TALLIES OF CERTAIN PRECINCTS IN THE 2008 PRESIDENTIAL
GENERAL ELECTION**

(ALL SUPERVISORIAL DISTRICTS) (3-VOTE)

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT YOUR BOARD:

Approve the conduct of snap tally services in 17 of the 4,394 precincts throughout the County in the November 4, 2008 Presidential General Election at the request of Edison Media Research.

PURPOSE /JUSTIFICATION OF RECOMMENDED ACTION:

For many years, Los Angeles County has made snap tally services available, in accordance with Election Code requirements, to the news media to enable them to establish voting trends in certain election contests. For this election, the request is for snap tally results in the Presidential contest only.

Snap tallies are specifically authorized by California Elections Code Sections 14440-14443. Edison Media Research has requested the snap tallies indicating a public interest in the information and need for early tabulation.

Implementation of Strategic Plan Goals

This request supports the County strategic plan:

Goal No. 1: Service Excellence: Provide the public with easy access to quality information and services that are both beneficial and responsive.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

The total costs to the Registrar for the snap tallies are estimated at \$425 to cover an additional \$25 stipend for each Inspector performing snap tally services.

FACTS AND PROVISIONS/ LEGAL REQUIREMENTS:

Snap tallies do not interfere with the conduct of the election. Snap tallies take place after all the polls have closed and do not, in any way, delay the County's tally of election results. The attached statement from Edison Media Research reaffirms their policy of not releasing such results until all the polls in the State of California have closed.

IMPACT ON CURRENT SERVICES:

No impact on current services. Snap tally services allow the news media to establish voting trends in certain election contests and provide this information to the citizens of Los Angeles County.
