Semi-Final Official Results Reported for the March 17, 2015 Senate District 21 Special Primary Election

Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced semi-final official results for the March 17, 2015 Senate District 21 Special Primary Election for the cities of Lancaster, Palmdale and parts of Santa Clarita. A total of 15,660 ballots were processed and counted, with 5.07% of eligible registered voters casting ballots.

The official election canvass period begins on March 18 and ends on March 27. During the official canvass, all outstanding ballots will be verified and tallied. The RR/CC will also conduct a one-percent manual audit.

On March 27, the RR/CC is scheduled to certify the results. On March 31, the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors is scheduled to declare the election results official.
