Candidate must also file a Declaration of Candidacy and Ballot Designation worksheet during this period. (E. C. §§ 8028, 8040, 8041, 8062 and 10704 and 13107.3) NOTE: Fax not acceptable.</p> <p>CANDIDATE STATEMENTS</p> <p>During this period, candidates may file a candidate statement not to exceed the word limitation prescribed by the district governing body (200 or 400 words) for inclusion with the Official Sample Ballot. The statement shall be filed no later than the last day to file declarations of candidacy. (E. C. §§ 10540 and 13307)</p> <p>OFFICER'S CANDIDATE STATEMENT</p> <p>During this period, the officer sought to be recalled may file, along with payment or estimate cost or printing statement, a candidate statement not to exceed 200 words for inclusion with the Sample Ballot booklet. The statement and fee shall be submitted no later than the last day to file nomination documents. (E. C. Secs. 13307 & 11327)</p>
FEB. 10 (M) E-113		<p>NOTICE OF ELECTION – PUBLICATION</p> <p>Last day to publish a notice of election. A general press release providing information on the elective offices and the telephone number to call regarding candidate nomination procedures shall also be issued. (E. C. §§ 12101 and 12102)</p>
APR. 6 (M) E-57	MAY 19 (Tu) E-14 5:00 P.M.	<p>WRITE-IN CANDIDATE PERIOD</p> <p>A name written on a ballot will not be counted unless the person has filed a declaration of candidacy during this period stating that he or she is a write-in candidate for the election. (E. C. §§ 8600 and 8601)</p>

MAR. 7 (Sa) E-87	MAR. 16 (M) E-78	PUBLIC EXAMINATION PERIOD FOR CANDIDATE STATEMENTS/CANDIDATE NAMES AND BALLOT DESIGNATIONS During this period, candidate statements, candidate names, and ballot designations shall be open for public examination. A fee may be charged to any person obtaining a copy of the material. Any person may challenge the aforementioned candidate information by filing a petition for writ of mandate. (E. C. § 13313 and 13314)
APR. 1 (W) E-62	APR. 3 (F) E-60	TRANSLITERATION REVIEW PERIOD First and last day candidates may review transliteration of their names. Requests for changes must be submitted to the county elections official no later than the last day of the review period.
MAR. 12 (Th) E-82		RANDOMIZED ALPHABET DRAWING BY SECRETARY OF STATE The Secretary of State shall hold a public drawing to determine the order of candidate names on ballot by randomly drawing each letter of the alphabet. (E. C. § 13112(d))
APR. 18 (Sa) E-45		MILITARY AND OVERSEAS BALLOTS Last day for the county elections official to transmit ballots and balloting materials to absent military or overseas voters who have requested them by this date. (E. C. § 3114)
APR. 23 (Th) E-40	MAY 12 (Tu) E-21	MAILING OF SAMPLE BALLOTS A sample ballot booklet shall be mailed to each voter in the district during this period. (E. C. §§ 13300,13303(b) and 13304)

MAY 4 (M) E-29	<p>MAILING OF VOTE BY MAIL BALLOTS First day the elections official delivers Vote By Mail ballots in compliance with E.C. 3001. (E.C. § 3010 and 3206)</p> <p>VOTE CENTER STAFF - APPOINTMENT Last day to appoint staff and designate vote centers . A notice of appointment shall be mailed to all staff. (E. C. 4005 (a)(6)(A) §§ 12286, 12307 and 12319)</p>
MAY 18 (M) E-15	<p>CLOSE OF REGISTRATION Last day to register or transfer to vote in the election. (E. C. § 2102 and 2107)</p> <p>PROCESSING OF VOTE BY MAIL BALLOTS The processing of vote by mail ballots may commence on the 10th business day before the election, but the results of the tally shall not be released until after the polls close. (E. C. § 15101(b))</p>
MAY 19 (Tu) E-14 5:00 P.M.	<p>WRITE-IN CANDIDATE DECLARATION DEADLINE Last day for a candidate to file a declaration of candidacy stating that he or she is a write-in candidate for the election. (E. C. §§ 8600 and 8601)</p> <p>BILINGUAL VOTE CENTER STAFF Last day to prepare list of appointed bilingual precinct officers. (E. C. § 12303(d))</p>
MAY 23 (Sa) E-10	<p>TALLY CENTER LOCATION - PUBLICATION On or before this date a notice specifying the public place to be used as the central tally center for counting the ballots shall be published once in a newspaper of general circulation within the district. (E. C. § 12109 and Govt. § 6061)</p>

JUNE 2 (Tu) 8:00 P.M. ELECTION DAY		<p>ELECTION DAY Polls open 7:00 a.m. and close 8:00 p.m. (E. C. § 14212) NOTE: If at the hour of closing, there are any other qualified voters in the polling place or in line at the door, who have not been able to vote since appearing, the polls shall be kept open a sufficient amount of time to enable them to vote. (E. C. § 14401)</p> <p>VOTE BY MAIL BALLOTS RETURNED—8:00 P.M. Last day for Vote By Mail ballots to be received or turned in personally by the voter at any polling place in the jurisdiction. An authorized representative may return the voted ballot under specified conditions. (E. C. §§ 3017 and 3021) Any vote by mail ballot cast under this division shall be timely cast if it is received by the voter's elections official via the United States Postal Service or a bona fide private mail delivery company no later than three days after election day in addition to the provisions set forth in E. C. 3020, Sections 1 and 2. (E. C. § 3020(b) Section 1 and 2)</p>
JUNE 3 (W) E+1	JUNE 15 (M) E+13	<p>OFFICIAL CANVASS During this period, the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk is tentatively scheduled to complete the official canvass.</p> <p>NOTE: On June 15, 2020 the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk is scheduled to certify the election results to the SOS. On June 23, 2020, the Board of Supervisors is tentatively scheduled to declare the election officially concluded.</p>

If any candidate receives a majority of all votes cast at the special primary election, he or she shall be declared elected and the special general election shall not be held.
(E.C. § 10705)

If no candidate receives a majority of votes cast at the special primary election, the names of the top two vote getters shall be placed on the special general election ballot. (E.C. § 10706)
