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Pomona Residents Need to Request a Vote by Mail Ballot by May 7 *Senate District 32 Special General Election Scheduled on May 14, 2013*

The Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean Logan reminds Pomona voters to request a Vote by Mail Ballot by Tuesday, May 7 for the May 14, 2013 Senate District 32 Special General (Runoff) Election. The application period for Vote by Mail Ballots begins today.

The RR/CC started mailing more than 15,000 Vote by Mail Ballots to voters on April 4.
