Final Official Results Certified for Sept. 17, 2013 Special Primary Elections

Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced final official results for the Sept. 17, 2013 Special Primary Elections.

A total of 24,483 ballots were processed and counted for Assembly District 45, with 5.64% of eligible registered voters casting ballots. A total of 24,999 ballots were processed and counted for the old Senate District 26, with 9.98% of eligible registered voters casting ballots.

The Official Election Canvass period began on Sept. 18 and ended on Sept. 27. During the Official Canvass, all outstanding provisional and Vote by Mail ballots were verified and tallied. The RR/CC also conducted a 1% Manual Audit.

The results were certified to the California Secretary of State today. On Oct. 1, the Board of Supervisors is tentatively scheduled to declare the election results official.
