L.A. County Voters Have Until Oct. 29 to Request a Vote by Mail Ballot *Local and Municipal Consolidated Elections Takes Place on Nov. 5, 2013*

The Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean Logan reminds L.A. County voters to request a Vote by Mail ballot by Tuesday, Oct. 29 for the Nov. 5, 2013 Local and Municipal Consolidated Elections. The application period for Vote by Mail ballots begins today.

The RR/CC began mailing approximately 500,000 Vote by Mail ballots to voters today.
