Final Official Results Certified for the March 17th Senate District 21 Special Primary Election

Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced final official results for the March 17, 2015 Senate District 21 Special Primary Election.

The results were certified today to the California Secretary of State. On March 31, the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors is scheduled to declare the election results official.

The Official Election Canvass period began on March 18. During the official canvass, all outstanding ballots were verified and tallied. The RR/CC also conducted a 1% manual audit.
