#### First Election Results Update for the August 13 City of Los Angeles Council District 12 Special Runoff Election

**LOS ANGELES** – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced the first ballot counting update for the City of Los Angeles Council District 12 Special Runoff Election.

The update includes **5,539** ballots processed since Election Night, consisting of Vote by Mail and Provisional ballots:

- **Provisional Ballots:** 1,105
- **Vote by Mail Ballots:** 4,434

The total election results count is now **37,728**, which is **22.30%** of eligible Los Angeles County voters. These results are subject to change throughout the [Official Election Canvass](#).

The estimated number of outstanding ballots left to be counted is **115** Vote by Mail ballots.

This estimate includes additional Vote by Mail Ballots postmarked on or before Election Day and received through today (E+3).
