June 5, 2012 PRIMARY ELECTION

VOTER REGISTRATION DEADLINE APPROACHING

LA County residents are encouraged to register to vote and verify voter registration status.

Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean Logan today reminded Los Angeles County residents that the voter registration deadline for the upcoming Presidential Primary Election on June 5, 2012 is Monday, May 21st. There are nearly two million adult citizens in Los Angeles County who are not registered to vote.

Los Angeles County residents who are U.S. Citizens and will be at least 18 years of age by Election Day should register to vote. Registered voters, who have moved, legally changed their name, want to change their political party, or recently completed a sentence for a felony conviction should re-register to vote.

Visit www.lavote.net to download a voter registration form online. Voter registration forms are also available by calling the Voter Registration Request Line – (800) 481-VOTE (8683) or at over 1,240 locations across the County – including Department of Motor Vehicles offices, libraries, post offices, public assistance offices (DPSS, WIC), fire stations and City Clerks offices. Completed forms must be submitted to the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk.

Voter registration forms may be returned by mail or in-person. Postmarked voter registration forms will be accepted. Also, on Monday, May 21, the RR/CC's office, located at 12400 Imperial Highway in Norwalk, will remain open until midnight to allow for the receipt of new registrations through the deadline. Registration forms and a deposit box for completed forms will be available in the front lobby. RR/CC staff will be in the lobby until midnight to assist prospective voters who may have questions or require assistance.
