DEADLINE TO REQUEST VOTE BY MAIL BALLOT APPROACHING

Tuesday, May 29th is the Last Day to Request a Vote by Mail Ballot for June 5th Election

Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean Logan is reminding voters who wish to vote by mail that the deadline to request vote by mail ballots for the June 5, 2012, Primary Election is Tuesday, May 29, 2012.

Registered voters have several options for requesting a Vote by Mail ballot:

- Apply online at www.lavote.net. Click Voting and Elections. Then click the Vote by Mail Information.
- Complete the Vote by Mail Application on the back cover of the Official Sample Ballot booklet;
- Send a written request to the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk, Vote by Mail Section, P.O. Box 30450, Los Angeles, CA 90030-0450;
- Apply in person at the RR/CC's Office, 12400 Imperial Highway, 3rd floor, Room 3002, Norwalk.

Voters can check the status of their request or if their voted Vote by Mail ballot has been received online at www.lavote.net. If a voter has applied for a vote by mail ballot and has not received it within a week, they should check the status of their request online at www.lavote.net or they can call the RR/CC Vote by Mail Voter Section at (562) 466-1323, between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. weekdays.

Under special circumstances, a voter may also request an emergency Vote by Mail ballot from May 29 through June 5, by applying in person or by sending a designee to the RR/CC Headquarters, 12400 Imperial Hwy., Norwalk.
