Second Ballot Counting Update for the June 7th Presidential Primary

LOS ANGELES - Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced the second counting update for the June 7th Presidential Primary Election.

The update includes **201,020** ballots processed since election night consisting of 187,794 Vote by Mail ballots and 13,226 precinct ballots. The total election results count is now at **1,706,798** which is **35.49%** of eligible Los Angeles County voters.

On July 1st, the RR/CC is scheduled to certify the election results. On July 5th, the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors is scheduled to declare the election results official.
