Registrar of Voters launches county wide push to assist with voter registration before deadline

The Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk announced today that it is setting up over a dozen voter registration locations throughout the County to assist voters before the deadline. The effort seeks to reach out to the three million adult citizens still not registered to vote. Registrar of Voters staff and volunteers will be on hand to assist voters. The effort is also being promoted by a coalition of local radio and television stations (Power 106, KROQ 106.7, AMP 97.1, KEARTH 101.1, Super Estrella 107.1, LA 18). The day will end with an event featuring the screening of the final Presidential debate at the East LA Civic Center beginning at 5 pm.

“On Monday, October 22nd, our Outreach Team will hit the streets to get the message out that it’s the last chance to register to vote in this Presidential election,” said Dean Logan, Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk, “With the launch of Online Voter Registration, there is no excuse not to register to vote. We have made it easy to register on our website.” (www.lavote.net) Eligible citizens must register by Monday, October 22 at midnight in order to vote in the November 6 General Election.

Los Angeles County residents who are U.S. Citizens and will be at least 18 years of age by Election Day can register to vote. Persons already registered but, who have moved, legally changed their name, or recently completed a sentence for a felony conviction should re-register to vote.
