# Top Two Primary

**The Top Two Primary** was adopted by voters in the June 8, 2010 Primary Election (Proposition 14–The Top Two Candidates Open Primary Act). The law changed the way that voters nominate candidates to run in the General Election.



The top-two candidates that received the most votes in the June primary in voter nominated offices moved on from the primary to the general election, regardless of their party preference.



For this election, voter nominated offices include United States Senator, United States Representative, State Senator, and Members of the State Assembly.



Voters may vote for any candidate on the ballot regardless of their party preference.
