



# VOTER REGISTRATION

*Every Vote Counts, Every Election Matters.*

## Register to vote if all of the following apply



You are a U.S. citizen.



You are a California resident.



You are not on parole for a felony.



You can pre-register to vote if you are at least 16.



You are eligible to vote if you are registered and at least 18.



### For homeless voters, please take special note of the following when completing a voter registration card:

- **Section 3 – CA driver's license, CA ID card # or SSN:** If voter does not have or remember this information, they may still register and vote. This is optional.
- **Section 4 – Describe location where you live:** Complete by describing location as best as possible. At a minimum use cross streets.
  - For example: In park located at the northwest corner of Los Angeles Street and 23rd Street.
- **Section 5 – Mailing address:** Complete with address where mail is received.
  - For example: Various organizations allow the usage of their address

Voters may receive assistance when completing voter registration card. Anyone filling out card for a voter must include information in the blue shaded box: Did someone help you fill out or deliver this form?

If sharing your address could put you in danger, you may be eligible to register to vote confidentially.

#### Who can request:

- The registrant or parent / legal guardian of the registrant.
- A child, grandparent, grandchild, sibling, spouse, or domestic partner of the registrant.

#### Payment:

- \$28 fee for birth certificate
- Cash
- Check / money order
  - Make payable to **Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk**
- Credit / debit card
  - Additional fee of \$1.75 will be charged

#### The following years are available:

- Birth certificates of U.S. citizens born in LA County from 1905 to the present.
- For birth certificates from Mexico, please contact the Mexican Consulate at 213-351-6800.

#### To waive the fee:

##### For Homeless Service Provider agencies assisting homeless individuals:

1. Complete the Affidavit of Homeless Status for Fee Exempt Certified Copy of Birth Certificate. Up to 3 copies may be requested per year. This form is provided by the California Department of Public Health.
2. Individuals may take form to any office listed above. Agencies may also mail form. Fax is not acceptable because original signature is needed.  
  
*\* When mailing, must include a notarized certificate of identity.*
3. When mailing, indicate whether birth certificate will be picked-up in person or an address where it should be mailed.
