***2.190.090 Fundraising Periods:**

Candidates for Countywide office such as Assessor may begin fundraising 18 months before the election. Candidates for the office of Member, Board of Supervisors may begin fundraising 15 months before the election.

****2.190.090 Fundraising Periods with one time extension of Proposition B Deadlines (approved on September 1, 2020)**

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, a candidate for county-wide office, controlled committee for a county-wide office, candidate for supervisor or controlled committee for a supervisor may accept contributions for the March 3, 2020 Primary Election for up to 12 months after the March 3, 2020 Primary Election, and may accept contributions for the November 3, 2020 General Election for up to the 12 months after the November 3, 2020 General Election.

*****2.190.100 Officeholder Accounts:**

No county officeholder who is running for County office may make any expenditures from his/her officeholder account during the period beginning six months prior to the Primary election, and ending on the day after the Primary election, or if the candidate is in a General election, ending the day after the General. This does not apply to the incumbent officeholders who are terming out.

******2.190.040 Contribution Limits:**

After the Primary election (effective March 4, 2020), the contribution limits for all run-off candidates are reset to \$300 until the Form 800 is filed. Contribution limits may change depending on the candidate's and his/her opponent's Form 800 selections.
