### First Election Results Update for the March 7<sup>th</sup> Election

**LOS ANGELES** – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced the first ballot counting update for the Consolidated Municipal and Special Elections.

The update includes **67,954** ballots processed since Election Night, consisting of Vote by Mail ballots. The total election results count is now **661,187**, which is **12.58%** of eligible Los Angeles County voters.
