Polls Closed and First Ballot Count for Congressional District 34 Special Primary Election

LOS ANGELES – The Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced the closing of the polls for the Congressional District 34 Special Primary Election.

The first Election Night ballot count includes **12,955** returned Vote by Mail ballots out of **127,755** Vote by Mail ballots issued in the district.

Updates to the tally will be made throughout the evening as ballots arrive from all 190 polling places to Norwalk Headquarters for central tabulation.
