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First Ballot Counting Update for the Nov. 5, 2013 Local and Municipal Consolidated Elections

Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced the first ballot counting update for the Nov. 5, 2013 Local and Municipal Consolidated Elections.

The update includes 24,643 ballots processed since Election Night, consisting entirely of Vote by Mail ballots. For vote totals on specific contests, visit www.lavote.net.

Please note these results are subject to change throughout the canvass period. The second ballot counting update is Tuesday, Nov. 12 at 1 p.m. All results and updates will be posted online at www.lavote.net as they become available.

The Official Election Canvass period begins on Nov. 7 and ends on Nov. 25. During the Official Canvass, all outstanding provisional and Vote by Mail ballots will be verified and tallied. The RR/CC will also conduct a 1% Manual Audit.

On Nov. 25, the RR/CC is tentatively scheduled to certify the results. On Nov. 26, the L.A. County Board of Supervisors is tentatively scheduled to declare the election results official.
